**Restoration of the former church of St. Anthony and the gardens of the convent of Poor Clares in Santa Fiora, Italy, 2009**

The building of the former church of St. Anthony and the adjoining gardens of the convent of Poor Clares is the extreme end of the village towards the Fiora valley.

Points were with the weather remained forgotten and abandoned and, beyond the boundary wall of the church, the area was characterized by major collapses of walls, layers of rubble and decay.

Restoration and a new arrangement made it possible to recover the masonry equipment, return to the public gardens, reopen vaulted systems at the base of the imposing walls, build new paved areas, a bar, spaces equipped for playing children and two small arenas for shows and music.

An articulated set of smooth cement floors which is simultaneously paving, prospectus, cover, takes the visitor from the square to the gardens.
